- Check weather conditions before hiking.

### 1 PASAR AGUNG ROUTE (SHORTEST ROUTE)

TOTAL TIME UP: ± 60 – 75 MINUTES  
TOTAL TIME UP: ± 1 – 1.5 HOURS

ROUTE	EST. TIME	DESCRIPTION
Pura Pasar Agung (± 1,500 mASL) → Kanginan Peak	± 30 – 40 minutes	Steep rocky terrain.
Kanginan Peak → Main Summit	± 30 minutes	Sandy and slippery trail.

★ **THE FASTEST!** Perfect for those who wake up late.

### 2 TOYA BUNGKAH ROUTE (FAVORITE ROUTE)

TOTAL TIME UP: ± 75 – 90 MINUTES  
TOTAL TIME UP: ± 1.5 HOURS

ROUTE	EST. TIME	DESCRIPTION
Basecamp Toya Bungkah (± 1,050 mASL) → Pos 1 (Pondok)	± 30 – 45 minutes	Through wide and gentle forest trail.
Pos 1 (Pondok) → Main Summit	± 45 minutes	Uphill with soil and some rocks.

Mountain motorcycle (ojek) service available up to ± 1,650 mASL.

### 3 SERONGGA ROUTE (SANDY ROUTE)

TOTAL TIME UP: ± 80 – 100 MINUTES  
TOTAL TIME UP: ± 1.5 – 2 HOURS

ROUTE	EST. TIME	DESCRIPTION
Banjar Serongga (± 1,100 mASL) → Forest Edge	± 40 minutes	Gentle trail through forest.
Forest Edge → Main Summit	± 40 – 50 minutes	Last 30 minutes very sandy and slippery.

★ Beautiful east side scenery with a different view.

### 4 CULALI / BUKIT MENTIK ROUTE (LONGEST ROUTE)

TOTAL TIME UP: ± 2.5 – 3 HOURS  
(up to 5 hours if leisurely)

ROUTE	EST. TIME	DESCRIPTION
Pos Culali (± 1,300 mASL) → Pos Bale Bengong	± 30 – 40 minutes	Rocky and sandy terrain.
Pos Bale Bengong → Pos Camp Culali (New Crater)	± 2 – 3 hours	Crossing black lava fields and sandy desert.
Pos Camp Culali → West Summit	± 30 – 45 minutes	Final steep ascent.

★ True adventure! Pass through black lava fields & new active crater.

### ROUTE COMPARISON SUMMARY

ROUTE	MAIN CHARACTERISTIC	TIME UP	ADVANTAGE
<b>Pasar Agung (Shortest)</b>	Shortest & Steep	1 – 1.5 Hours	Fastest to reach the summit, perfect for those who wake up late.
<b>Toya Bungkah (Favorite)</b>	Gentle & Comfortable	1.5 Hours	Safest for beginners, wide trail, and ojek (motorcycle taxi) option.
<b>Serongga (Sandy)</b>	Sandy & Slippery	1.5 – 2 Hours	Different east side scenery.
<b>Culali / Bukit Mentik (Longest)</b>	Extreme & Black Lava	3 – 4 Hours (up to 5 hours)	Pure adventure, pass through black lava & new active crater.

### IMPORTANT TIPS



Wear proper hiking shoes with good grip.



Bring at least 2 – 3 liters of water.



Wear warm clothes, temperature can drop drastically.



Use trekking pole, very helpful for ascents & descents.



Take your trash back down, keep nature clean.



Start early in the morning to enjoy the best sunrise.

Time estimates may vary depending on physical condition, weather, and field conditions.

# Mount Batur Hiking Route Summary

## **Pasar Agung Route (Shortest Route)**

The fastest hiking route to Mount Batur with steep rocky terrain and quick access to Kanginan Peak and the Main Summit.

## **Toya Bungkah Route (Favorite Route)**

The most popular beginner-friendly trail with gentle slopes, wide forest paths, and sunrise trekking access.

## **Serongga Route (Sandy Route)**

Scenic eastern-side trail featuring sandy and slippery terrain near the summit area.

## **Culali / Bukit Mentik Route (Longest Route)**

The longest and most adventurous route, crossing black lava fields and the newer volcanic crater zone.

## **Important Notes**

- Bring enough water and warm clothing.
- Start early for sunrise trekking.
- Use proper hiking shoes and trekking poles if needed.
- Respect local customs and keep the mountain clean.
