SUTER VILLAGE ROUTE (OFFICIAL MAIN ROUTE)

TOTAL ESTIMATED TIME UP: 2.5 - 3.5 HOURS

SECTOR	EST. TIME	TERRAIN DESCRIPTION
Registration → Post 1 (Pura Penyawat)	± 45 - 60 min	Wide and gentle trail on soil, through shady pine forest.
Post 1 (Pura Penyawat) → Post 2 (Pura Andong)	± 45 - 60 min	The trail narrows, loose soil, and the elevation starts to increase steadily.
Post 2 (Pura Andong) → Post 3 (Pura Puncak Tuluk Biyu)	± 60 - 90 min	The most challenging sector. Very steep, many big roots, slippery (dew), some sections need rope or root grip.
Post 3 (Pura Puncak Tuluk Biyu) → Summit Mount Abang	± 10 - 15 min	Easy walk along the ridge to the summit area with temple courtyard.

TOTAL TIME UP VIA SUTER: ± 2.5 - 3.5 HOURS
(Time down: ± 2 - 2.5 hours)

★ Official route, shady under pine trees, many active temples, safe and recommended for all hikers.

TRUNYAN VILLAGE ROUTE (HILL TRAVERSE ROUTE)

TOTAL ESTIMATED TIME UP: 4 - 5 HOURS

SECTOR	EST. TIME	TERRAIN DESCRIPTION
Trunyan Village → Hill Registration Point	± 30 min	Access via village road / motorbike track.
Hill Registration → Hilltop Bukit Trunyan (Savanna)	± 2 - 2.5 hours	Open dirt trail, very steep caldera slope, no shade (sunny). You will reach open savanna area.
Hilltop Bukit Trunyan → Summit Mount Abang (Ridge Connection)	± 1.5 - 2 hours	Traverse the narrow caldera ridge to the summit. Extreme trail, with deep cliffs on both sides.

TOTAL TIME UP VIA TRUNYAN TO ABANG: ± 4 - 5 HOURS
(Time down: ± 3 - 4 hours)

IMPORTANT WARNING (VIA TRUNYAN)
The ridge connection from Bukit Trunyan to Mount Abang is very extreme, unofficial, with steep cliffs on both sides and landslide risk. Not recommended for beginners or in bad weather / strong wind.

★ Open savanna, wider view of Lake Batur, physically more demanding, and very risky.

ROUTE CHARACTER COMPARISON



VIA SUTER (OFFICIAL)

- ✓ Shady under pine trees.
- ✓ Official and safe route.
- ✓ Many active temples (pura).
- ✓ Steady climb with tough sections near the summit.



VIA TRUNYAN (HILL TRAVERSE)

- ✓ Dominated by open savanna.
- ✓ Unobstructed view of Lake Batur.
- ✓ More physically demanding.
- ✓ Very risky and unofficial trail.

IMPORTANT TIPS

Use hiking shoes with good grip.

Bring at least 1.5 - 2 liters of water.

Wear warm clothes, it can be cold on the top.

Use trekking pole, very helpful for ascents and descents.

Take your trash back down.

Start early in the morning to enjoy the sunrise.

Mount Abang Hiking Route Summary

Suter Village Route (Official Main Route)

The safest and most recommended route to Mount Abang, passing through pine forests and several active temples. Suitable for beginners and spiritual trekking activities.

Trunyan Village Route (Hill Traverse Route)

A challenging ridge traverse route through Bukit Trunyan savanna with steep cliffs and exposed terrain. Recommended only for experienced hikers with good physical condition.

Important Notes

- Start hiking early for the best sunrise experience.
- Bring enough water and warm clothing.
- Use proper hiking shoes and trekking poles.
- Respect local customs and keep nature clean.
